### Program Dates: May 17 - June 30, 2013

**Total Program Cost \$5600**

**(\$5300 program fee + \$300 non-refundable Study Abroad application fee)**

It includes tuition, housing with breakfast, a 3-day excursion related to the program within the Czech Republic, field trips, cultural events such as opera, ballet or jazz club performances, visits to galleries and museums, a travel pass for use on Prague's public transport, a city map and phrasebook, Wi-Fi internet access and international accident and health insurance. Not included: \$300 Study Abroad non-refundable application fee, airfare, meals (other than breakfast), personal expenses and visa fees (required only if you intend travelling in Europe over 90 days).

#### **Early Decision Application Deadline: December 7, 2012**

For early consideration and acceptance, the Study Abroad application fee, all study abroad online forms and a \$500 Prague Program deposit must be completed by the deadline.

#### **Application Deadline: February 8, 2013**

Study Abroad application fee and a \$500 Prague Program deposit are due and all study abroad online forms must be completed.

**How to Apply:** Applications are available online on Study Abroad's website at <http://studyabroad.ncsu.edu>. The non-refundable deposit of \$500 is applied towards the program fee once accepted. Should the program be cancelled or you are not accepted, the application fee and deposit will be refunded. Check for scholarships and financial aid at the Study Abroad Office.
