

Checklist of Things to Consider when completing your EDP304 Schema Representation:

Make sure to include:

- Include personal examples
- Show and explain connections between concepts
- Match your analogy with your information
- Put in 1st person
- Make material easy to read
- Avoid slapping a paper on the posterboard
- Avoid copying info from book/class slides/internet
- Have a clear organization/flow/pattern--direct the eyes of the reader
- Incorporate course concepts
- Make it apparent what you will teach or do

Avoid:

- No Pull-up pieces/covered information (velcro)
- No Presentation boards
- Pieces on top of the board/Pieces hanging off the board
- No glitter
- No Books that open
- No messy handwritten information
- Mention of multiple intelligences, learning styles, etc. without justification
- Avoid numerous spelling/grammar errors/simple mistakes (Proofread!)
